

## Kitty tuna treats

### Ingredients:

1 tin tuna in brine – drained well.

½ cup whole wheat flour (can replace with rice flour).

½ tsp dried catnip.

1 large egg – beaten.

½ cup water.

1. Mash tuna till no longer chunky, then mix with the egg in 1 bowl.
2. Add Flour and catnip to wet mixture and mix.
3. Slowly add water till the mixture forms a doughy, slightly sticky ball.
4. Grease a baking tray or sheet. Preheat oven to 180° C.
5. Using 2 spoons or small cookie scoops, make small balls and place about 1.5cm apart on the baking tray.
6. Bake for 25min.
7. Cool before serving.

If your cat is intolerant of or allergic to tuna, replace with chicken, salmon or crushed/softened pellets from the cat's normal diet.

If intolerant of wheat, use rice or potato flour.

If intolerant of egg, use a tin of soft food which the cat can eat without issue.
