

## Plants that are not safe for dogs



Although this list is not all-inclusive, here are some common plants that are not entirely safe for your dog to chew on.

African daisy, African violet, Amaryllis, Apricot pits, Autumn crocus, Azalea.

Baby's breath, Bamboo, Bamboo palm, Bottlebrush.

Camelia, Carnation, Carob, **CYCADS!**

Daffodils, Date palm, Dieffenbachia, Elephant ear.

Ferns – Asparagus, Boston, bracken, bold sword.

Iris, Ivy.

Kalanchoe, Lillies.

Morning glory, Mother-in-law's tongue, Oak tree, Oleander, Onion.

Philodendron, Primrose, Privet.

Rhododendron.

Sago palm.

Yesterday-today-and-tomorrow, yew.
